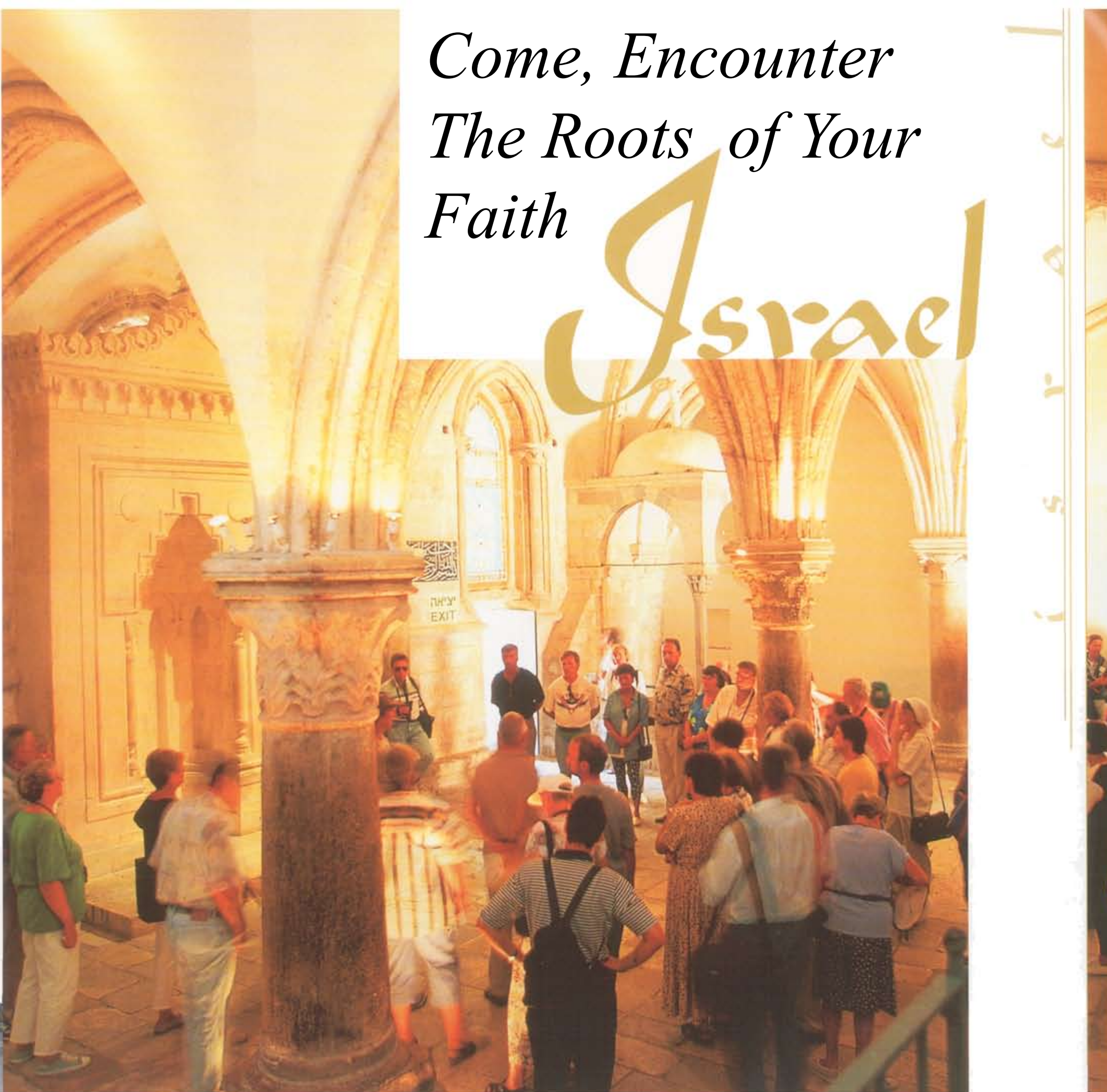

MEGIDDO Last great battle of the age will be fought (Rev. 6:12-16). Canaanite city, water tunnel.

MT. CARMEL Elijah's contest with the prophets of Baal (1 Kings 18:19-40).

HAIFA Beautiful overview of the city and coast.

NAZARETH Annunciation was made to Mary (Luke 1).

BANIAS FALLS One of the Jordan River headwaters and where Philip Antipas, built a temple and city in the honor of Augustus Caesar later called Caesarea Philippi.

CAESAREA PHILIPPI Peter's confession of Jesus' divinity (Matthew 16:13-20).

SEA OF GALILEE Jesus walked on the water (Mark 6:45-52).

CAPERNAUM Jesus made His home (Matthew 4:13).

MT. OF BEATITUDES Sermon on the Mount (Matthew 5-7).

BETHSAIDA Feeding of the 5,000 (Luke 9:10-17).

CANA Jesus' first miracle (John 2:1-11).

DAMASCUS ROAD Paul's vision (Acts 9).

MT. HERMON Miracle of Transfiguration (Matthew 17:1-13).

GIDEON'S SPRING SACHNE Army of 300 chosen (Judges 7:1-8), natural Hot Springs, picnic sight.

MT. GILBOA Death of King Saul (I Samuel 31:1-8).

BETH-SHEAN Best preserved Roman amphitheater in Israel.

MT. OF OLIVES A panoramic view of the City. The slopes hold the graves of pious Jews who died with the hope that the resurrection of the dead will begin here.

PALM SUNDAY ROAD Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem (Luke 19:35-38).

GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE Jesus' prayer and betrayal (Luke 22:39-53).

WAILING WALL Western portion of Herod's temple area wall.

TEMPLE MOUNT Dome of the Rock, Eastern Gate, prophecy of its destruction (Matthew 24: 1-2).

POOL OF BETHESDA Jesus healed the lame man (John 5: 1-16).

UPPER ROOM Site of the Last Supper (Luke 22: 7-20).

ANTONIA FORTRESS Site of Jesus' trial (Matthew 27:2-31)

CALVARY Jesus was crucified (John 19:16-37). Site of the Garden Tomb (John 19:28-41).

BURNT HOUSE A house burnt by the Romans where all household utensils and pottery were found almost untouched only blackened by the fire.

POOL OF SILOAM Jesus healed the blind man (John 9:1-12).

HEZEKIAH'S TUNNEL Underground waterway (II Chron. 32:2-4).

KINGS TOMB Example of a rolling stone.

SOLOMON'S QUARRIES Blocks hewn for the Temple (I Kings 5:15-18).

CITY MODEL Model of Jerusalem at the time of Jesus.

YAD VASHEM Memorial to the victims of the Holocaust.

SHRINE OF THE BOOK Museum Israel - the Dead Sea Scrolls.

BETHLEHEM Church of the Nativity; shepherds received the Good News (Luke 2:8-20).

MASSADA Herod's magnificent palace and fortress. Last heroic Jewish stand against the Romans in 73 C.E. and mass suicide of its 960 defenders.

DEAD SEA The area of Sodom and Gomorrah (Gen:13:10-13,14,18,19). Lowest place on the surface of the earth.

EIN-GEDI David took refuge from Saul and cut off his skirt (I Samuel 22:29 24:22).

QUMRAN Where the Essenes wrote the Dead Sea Scrolls discovered here in 1947 after 2000 years.

JERICHO The Oldest city in the world. The earliest findings of defensive walls known to mankind and the earliest pottery unearthed in Israel. Conquered by Joshua (Joshua 6:13-17).

VALLEY OF ELAH David killed Goliath (I Samuel 17).

BETH SHEMESH Ark recovered from the Philistines (I Samuel 6).

TOUR CONDITIONS:

TOUR PRICE: Price per person, double occupancy, based on air, hotel and exchange rates at time of printing. Any increase in airfare and ground cost due to inflation, fuel surcharge, VAT tax, if tour falls under specified number, dollar devaluation, will be pro-rated and passed on to tour members. Air travel will be on a scheduled IATA/ARC carrier.

INCLUSIONS: Israeli buffet breakfast and hotel dinner daily in Israel, all entrance fees, tips, taxes, service charges, transfers, medical insurance while in Israel (for travelers under age 75), and portorage of one suitcase.

NOT INCLUDED: Passport, portorage at U.S. airports, travel insurance, any expenses incurred resulting from injury or accident, loss of or damage to luggage, and items of a personal nature; coffee, tea, mineral water and food or beverages not on the regular menu of the included meals, telephone calls, items from hotel room, laundry.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Twin bedded rooms with private bath. Single rooms available at additional charge. Any passenger unable to find a roommate must pay the single supplement. Triple rooms include a rollaway bed for the third person in the room.

SIGHTSEEING: As described, subject to local conditions at the time of tour. Itinerary may be changed at the discretion of the tour director or land operator.

MEMBERSHIP: The organizer has the right to refuse any applicant considered incompatible with the interests of the party as a whole, and may require a physician medical clearance form. Applying for membership constitutes consent to abide by the discretion of the organizer and to defray any expenses resulting from dismissal from the tour. Tour is based on a minimum number of participants. In case of less, there may be a price increase.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: Each passenger is responsible for securing a passport valid for at least 6 months from the date of tour termination. You should do this immediately. No visas/inoculations required for U.S. citizens. Extensions to other countries may require a visa. Travelers should check with their physicians prior to travel overseas.

BAGGAGE: One bag per person is allowed to be checked with total dimension not to exceed 62 linear inches (length+width+height). Maximum weight – 50 lbs. A carry-on bag of 45 linear inches is allowed but must fit under seat. Space on the buses limit all travelers to one checked and one carry-on bag. You will be advised of any additional restrictions that may apply. *Excess baggage charges from tour operator and/or airlines may apply.*

CANCELLATION/REFUNDS/LATE BOOKING: Full refund, less \$200.00 administrative fee, will be made up to 90 days prior to departure; 90-46 days, \$500.00 penalty per person; 45-30 days, \$750.00 penalty per person; less than 30 days, nonrefundable. All nonrefundable airfare and overseas operation cancellation fees will be added to the above. All cancellations must be submitted in writing and will take effect upon date of receipt by Journeys Unlimited, Inc. (fax is accepted, 215 364-5606). Please note the above penalties are per person. *We strongly advise cancellation insurance*, which may grant full refund due to illness or unforeseen events. Limitations may apply. Insurance applications may be obtained from group leader or Journeys Unlimited. Please note that if insurance is taken out within 21 days of initial deposit, the pre-existing condition clause may be waived. See application or call TravelEx for details. Registrations received within 30 days of departure are subject to a \$100 per person surcharge to offset last minute communications between airlines, hotels and land operators. Expenses incurred as a result of special delivery or overnight delivery services of tour documents or information to late registrants will be passed to tour members.

REFUND OR EXCHANGE OF UNUSED

ARRANGEMENTS: Unused hotel accommodations, meals, tour, flights, transportation or other services are not refundable or exchangeable for other accommodations, services or features.

ITINERARY CHANGES: A \$75 charge per person (plus any applicable fare/tour difference), per change will be assessed for those wishing to deviate from the prepared group itinerary. No changes can be accepted within 30 days of departure. Itinerary change fees are non-refundable. A \$50 non-refundable research fee is required for anyone wishing to extend their trip beyond Israel. If the extension is booked, the \$50 will be applied against the total amount due.
